Enrollment – What is needed?

- Age Requirements. Children must be:
 - 5-years old by Sept. 1, 2022, OR
 - 5-years old by Dec. 1, 2022, with a signed waiver
- **Proof of Residency**. Parents must have:
 - Current property tax statement AND a current utility bill
 - Current lease agreement AND a current utility bill, OR
 - Home closing papers within six months
- **Certified birth certificate**
- ☐ Immunization records
- □ Vision screening results
- Parent picture identification (ID)



State Immunization Requirements*

- DTaP 5 doses
- Polio 4 doses
- MMR 2 doses
- HepB 3 doses
- Varicella 2 doses or immunity
- Vision Test
 Proof of vision testing

* MUST HAVE BY 5 YEARS OF AGE – or have a waiver on file obtained from Oakland County Health Department



New Waiver Requirements

- Non-medical vaccination waivers must be obtained at the Oakland County Health Department
- Medical Vaccination waivers must be obtained at the office of the child's physician
- Vaccination waivers are good for one year
- School districts can no longer issue immunization waivers
