



Alpha R. Musson

The dedication of the Alpha R. Musson Elementary School signifies a tribute to teachers, administrators, school board members and community leaders. It is fitting that we honor a person that has served our community in so many capacities.

As a teacher he was respected by his students and was innovative in his approach to teaching. As the principal of Rochester High School from 1934-46, he improved the quality of instruction. As a school board member, he helped direct the district through a prior era of growth, when we were also in the process of building new schools. As a community leader he was a charter member of many community organizations as well as serving as the secretary of the Oakland County Tuberculosis Association (1946-1960), where through his initiative the incidences of tuberculosis was cut in half. From 1960-1970, Al Musson returned to doing what he enjoyed most, teaching and working with students in Rochester.

Mr. Al Musson attended Alma College where he received his Bachelor of Science degree in chemistry. In 1935 he received a Master of Arts degree in education from the University of Michigan. To the youth of Rochester he was a teacher, mentor, counselor, and a patient friend.

Musson Elementary School is dedicated to the memory of a man who believed a school is a place "Where a child's future begins."
